



**SEIU Local 284 Constitution & Bylaws ARTICLE V –  
Nomination and Election of Officers**

**Section 7** All nominations for officers of this Local Union shall be made in open meetings. All nominations shall be in writing, designating the name of the person nominated, the office for which nominated and the nominee's program of goals and objectives for the office being sought. The candidate must be personally present to accept the nomination or have submitted a written signed and notarized statement of his or her acceptance prior to the nominations meeting. Election shall be by secret mail ballot. Write-in candidates and proxy voting shall not be permitted. A brief profile by each candidate of 100 words or less will be mailed out with the ballots. If the candidate desires to take advantage of this option, the candidate must submit their profile in the union office no later than 4:00 P.M. on the Monday following nominations.
